To train volunteers in order that they can provide emergency shelter and rescue for domestic animals when responding during a disaster

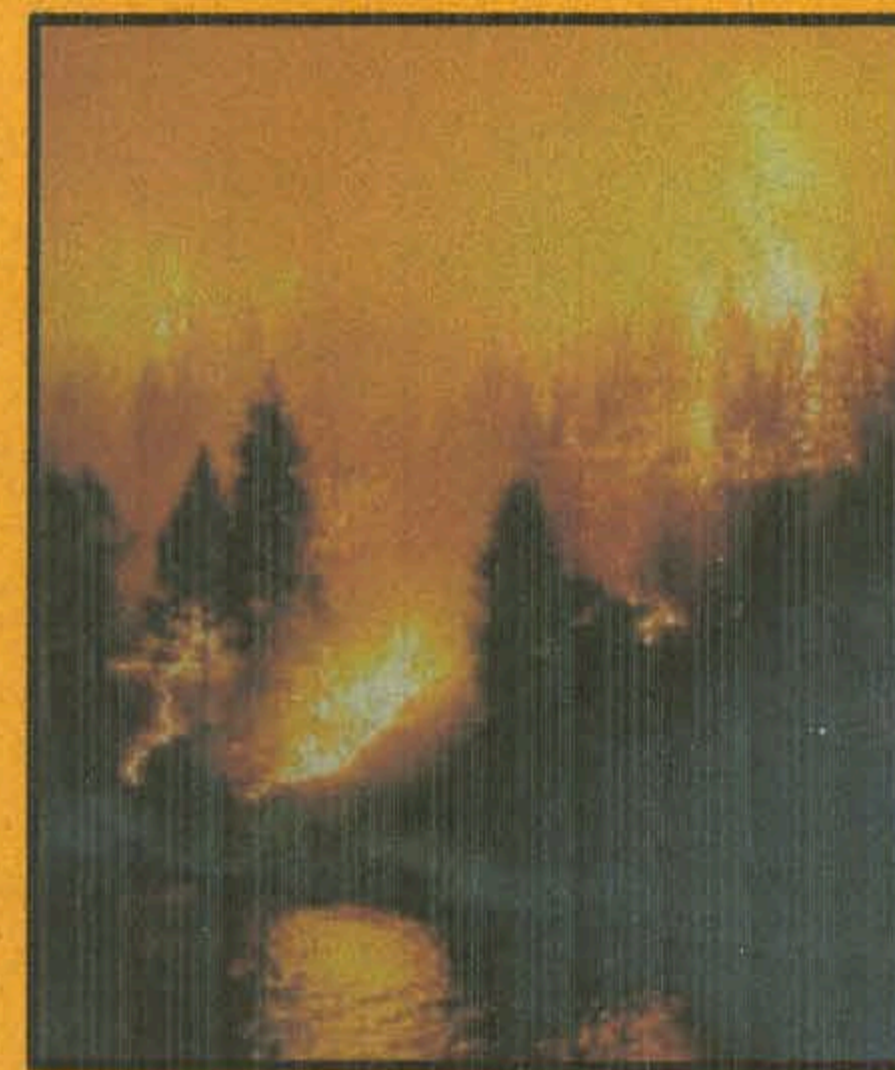
To raise funds for supplies, medical treatment for animals, training costs and expenses incurred by volunteers during a disaster
